

Download Overdrive eBooks to a Kindle

You will need a valid library card, PIN, Internet access, and an Amazon account.

1. On the computer or Kindle:

Go to www.eaudiocatalog.ocln.org.

(If using a Kindle Fire, the **Overdrive Media Console** app will also work: see separate guide for [App-ready devices](#))

2. Select an eBook:

At top right, click **Sign In**, and enter your library card & PIN.

Use the **Menu** bar or icon to view browsing options;

select **Account** to view your bookshelf or holds;

use the **Search** box to look for a specific title or author.

On any Search Results page, select **Show me only titles with copies available** to see items available for immediate download.

(**Show me my library's collection** shows all titles.)

Select the cover of a book you'd like to read.

Select **Borrow**.

Select **Download** and choose Kindle format.

Select **Confirm & Download**.

3. Page opens to Amazon.com:

Select **Get Library Book**.

If you haven't already, you'll need to sign in to Amazon.

Choose **Deliver to** the device of your choice (this device must have access to a wireless network).

4. If you do not have WiFi access, transfer eBook via USB:

After the **Deliver to** screen, select **Download now**, then save to the desktop.

Attach Kindle to computer via USB cable.

Open Kindle icon, and drag eBook into documents folder.

NOTE: Return books early by using the Action button under "Manage My Kindle" on Amazon.com.

Download Overdrive eBooks to an iPad / iPhone / App-ready device

You will need a valid library card, PIN, and Internet access.

1. Set up device for Overdrive

Download **Overdrive Media Console** app from the App Store.

Register for an Adobe ID account, or sign in if you already have one.

2. Select an eBook

Follow the on-screen instructions to access the Home menu and then **Add a Library**.

Touch the "star" beside **Old Colony Library Network**, then touch the network name to access the catalog.

Sign In with your library card and PIN.

Touch the Menu bar for search/browse options, the Person icon for your account info, or the Magnifying glass for Search.

On any Search Results page, touch **Show me only titles with copies available** to see items available for immediate download.

(**Show me my library's collection** shows all titles.)

Touch the cover of a book you'd like to read.

Touch **Borrow**.

Touch **Download** and choose a format – [Adobe EPUB works best with this App](#).

Touch **Confirm & Download**.

Touch **Menu** icon in upper left corner, then **Bookshelf** to view and read the eBook.

Download Overdrive eBooks to a Nook (1st edition or Simple Touch)

You will need a valid library card & PIN, and a computer with Internet access and Adobe Digital Editions installed.

1. On your personal computer:

Go to www.eaudiocatalog.ocln.org.

At the very bottom of the page, click **Software**.

Choose Adobe Digital Editions and select **Download Now** to begin the installation process on your computer.

2. Select an eBook:

Return to www.eaudiocatalog.ocln.org.

At top right, click **Sign In**, and enter your library card & PIN.

Use the **Menu** bar or icon to view browsing options; select **Account** to view your bookshelf or holds; use the **Search** box to look for a specific title or author.

On any Search Results page, select **Show me only titles with copies available** to see items available for immediate download.

(**Show me my library's collection** shows all titles.)

3. Download an eBook:

Click the cover of a book you'd like to read.

Click **Borrow**.

Click **Download**, and select either EPUB or PDF format.

Click **Confirm & Download**.

Click **Open**.

Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) will open and show eBook.

4. Transfer eBook to Nook:

Attach Nook to computer via USB cable.

If you haven't done so, create an Adobe ID to authorize Nook.

When complete, "Nook" will appear in sidebar of ADE.

Click **Library** icon in upper left corner.

Click and drag eBook to "Nook" on left sidebar.

Click on "Nook" to verify transfer of eBook.

Safely eject device.

5. Locate eBook on Nook:

Touch **My Library**, then **My Documents**.

Download Zinio Digital Magazines

This requires 2 accounts: (1) OCLN/Zinio, (2) Zinio.

Go to www.ocln.org/zinio

The first time you use this, click **Create New Account**.

Enter your library card number, click **Next**.

Fill in your email, password, name, then **Create Account**.

You'll be sent a confirmation email.

Open the email, follow the link, and you'll go to Zinio.

Enter email & password to **Log In**. (1st account)

You'll now be taken to the OCLN/Zinio collection.

Browse the collection and click on a magazine.

A window will open, asking you to **Complete Checkout**.

The first time you use this, you'll **Create a Zinio Account**.

Fill in your name and password, then **Register**. (2nd account)

The magazine is now part of your "Zinio library."

NOTE: the page you are on now is part of Zinio, not OCLN. You'll see magazines here that OCLN does not provide. You will be asked you to pay for them if you select one.

ALSO NOTE: almost every step in this process opens a new page – OCLN to Zinio, Zinio to the magazine – so be aware of this.

To find more magazines, go back to the OCLN Zinio page.

Once in your Zinio library, click/touch the magazine to open.

Swipe the pages or, on a PC, click the directional arrows.

For smartphones, eReaders, etc., download the Zinio app.

This is where your chosen titles will be stored.

(This app is a *reader only*).

Kindle Fire users must go to Zinio.com (on the device), click "help," then click the FAQ about Kindle Fire to download app.
